Other than maintaining the Speed Warning device operational, nothing else has been achieved during November.

Outstanding is the non-slip coating renewal of the Recreation Ground play equipment. To avoid taking too much equipment out of use only one piece can be processed at a time. Each requires 2 coats of stain with a day between and can only be done when there is no frost or rain forecast over that period. Regretfully this last month has not provided these weather conditions and it looks like the weather for the first 2 weeks of December will similarly be preventing this work. It will be progressed as soon as conditions permit.

Leaf clearance on the paths surrounding the school is planned for the week commencing 8th January. Volunteers will be requested via the Parish newsletter.

There is significant leaf fall evident on the play area and on the surrounds of the MUA and the tennis court. Is this a task for this Group or for a second visit by the grounds contractor?
