## Recreation Ground Improvements Report

**March 2024**

The Recreation Ground Improvements Project is completed. Cllr Kirkby's article in the March OB News magazine details what has been achieved.

The trees, picnic tables, benches, bins new football pitch with lines and goals with nets all enhance the provision of facilities for residents of different ages, offering opportunities for a wider range of activities.

The watering of the trees will begin as the spring advances. David and Jackie Warren will be leading this initiative and a number of residents are involved, including some of our local students who are completing the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, as part of the community service component.

The tree watering will need the tap at the Recreation Ground to be mended and adapted to fit a hose which can connect to the water carrier that has recently been purchased.

Cllr Gaster has kindly volunteered to do this, and is in conversation with Cllr Kirkby as to fine details of purchases required.

**Proposal: It is proposed that the sum of approx. £50 be used to buy required parts to mend and change the tap fixing so that the water carrier can be easily filled.**
