

Proposed Public Right of Way (PROW) Sign Report

Background

At the November PC Meeting it was confirmed that correspondence was received from a local resident regarding issues experienced with riding horses on the PROWs in Texas Field. It was felt that most of the issues probably related to lack of understanding that some of the PROW were bridleways. It was resolved to consider this further and report back to the PC.

Mint Signs provided the lowest price for the last signs that were provided at the Recreation Ground.

Progress

Cllr Warwick has been asked whether someone at HCC can help by providing a high quality image for the PROW around “Texas Field” (at a larger scale than the one on the website), as well as the legend and definitions of uses for “Footpath” and “Bridleway” explaining and distinguishing these two types.

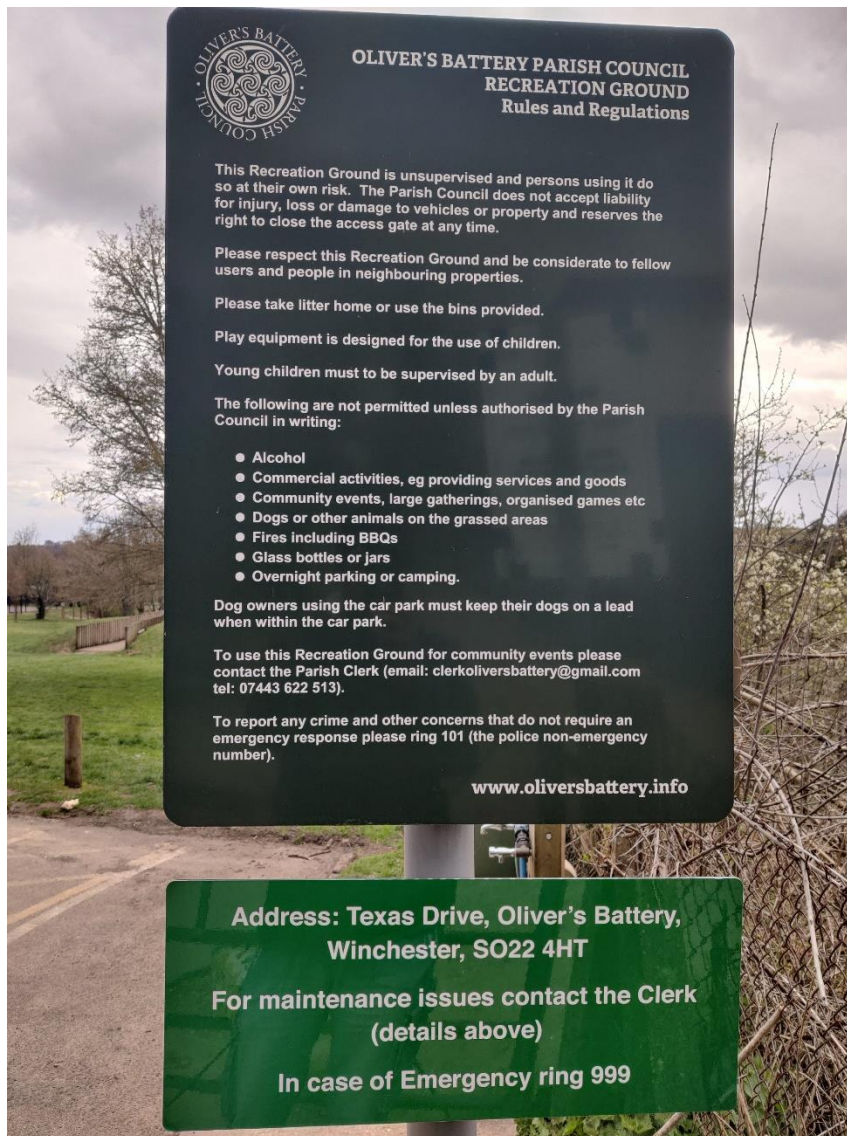
Cllr Warwick has also been asked if HCC provide this kind of sign.

If the other signs were adjusted. it is possible to add another sign to the existing post near the vehicular entrance to the Recreation Ground. This would avoid the cost of a new post.

The new sign and any adjustment of existing signs will be undertaken by the Handyperson Group, as it is only fixing and adjusting clips to the existing post.

Recommendations

- If HCC cannot provide the required sign at an economical price, Mint Signs are asked to quote for a A2 size (592 x 420 mm) sign with clips.
- If the price is less than £100 an order is placed for the sign or if over £100 the price is brought back to the next meeting for consideration.
